RESIDENTS' PARKING SCHEME

Instructions:

- 1. When parking in a Residents' Parking Place within the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea for the first time within the permitted hours on any day other than a Sunday, Christmas Day, Good Friday or a Bank Holiday, affix a parking token purchased from the Council of the Royal Borough of Kensington and Chelsea to the calendar so as to cover the day of the week which corresponds to the date on which the vehicle is left.
- 2. Display the permit and calendar on the front or nearside of the vehicle so that all the details on the faces thereof may readily be seen from outside the vehicle. A document holder for the permit and calendar is available free of charge from the Royal Borough Council.
- 3. Once a token is affixed to the calendar, no further charge is payable in respect of the leaving of the vehicle in any available residents' parking place within the Royal Borough on that date but the permit and calendar must be displayed.
- NOTE.—If the vehicle is disposed of or you change your address the permit and calendar MUST be surrendered to the Royal Borough Council.

The use of Parking Places may be suspended by Police Officers, Traffic Wardens or duly authorised Council Officers. Residents are reminded to check each day that the use of that Parking Place has not been suspended.
